Attendance

- Attendance is mandatory for every scheduled competition and practice.
- Students are **NOT ALLOWED** to make-up missed rounds. The only exception to this is for illness. If rounds cannot be made up the same week, the student's reserve score will be used for that week's scores.
- Missed rounds will be submitted as zeros to the MN Clay Target League. **SCORES OF ZERO WILL AFFECT THE ENTIRE TEAM'S WEEKLY SCORE.**

Absences/Scheduling Conflicts

- Students are allowed to shoot at a different scheduled time on Monday night, if they encounter a scheduling conflict. This must be arranged in advance.
- Adjustments to the schedule may be made to accommodate School activities such as Band/Orchestra/Choir concerts, State meets for activities such as FFA, DECA, etc.
- Adjustments WILL NOT be made for other athletic events.
- Students who will be absent or encounter a scheduling conflict will need to notify Coaching Staff as soon as possible with one of the following methods (Failure to notify coaches may affect Lettering):

Academic Eligibility

- The AAHS Clay Target League participants are subject to District 206 Eligibility requirements.
- AAHS Clay Target League Coaching staff receives weekly ineligibility reports from the District's Activities Office and will communicate with Students/Parents as notifications are received.
- **Ineligibility during Practice weeks:** Students are permitted to participate and scores will be submitted.
- **Ineligibility during Competition weeks:** Students are not permitted to participate until eligibility has been resolved and scores will be submitted as 'zero' for the weeks they are ineligible.
- If students are ineligible, it is very important that they reach out to their teachers and the activities office to get this cleared up as soon as possible. Forms may need to be signed by teachers and returned to the activities office to become eligible.
